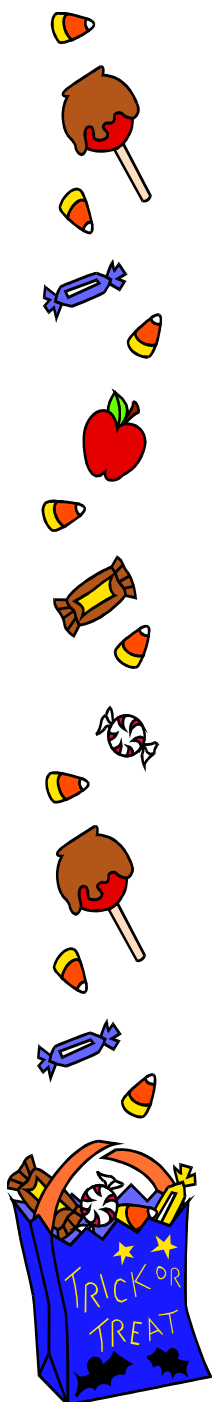

WEEDS!

As fall approaches the shadows are getting longer and the days shorter. This time reminds us of harvest and abundance. We start to think of the holidays soon to be here, but the last thing on our minds is **WEEDS!** Some have survived summer treatments. They have dropped seeds, which will lie dormant until the next growing season. Now is the time to eradicate next years crop. By applying a pre-emergent, such as "**Betasan**", we can virtually eliminate the seeds that are in our lawns. The timing is everything and this is one of the two times of the year to use a pre-emergent on our lawns. With the use of a fertilize spreader the application is easy and gives us a chance to control the weeds for next season. **Spot treat with herbicides:** such as "**MSMA**" for the large Dallis grass, crabgrass and other grasses in you lawn. As for the tall grass and weeds in your landscape you can weed eat or cut these with shears and then spray them with "**Roundup**" being careful to not spray surrounding plants. This is a good time of year for these treatments considering the temperature has to be above 60 degrees, just be sure to **choose the correct herbicide and apply it properly** following the directions carefully.

The fall season brings new 2005 vehicles to dealer's showrooms. What are the most popular choices? What will disappear?

The Toyota Celica will disappear after the 2005 model run. Toyota's MR2 will also be gone. The youth oriented Scion series will take over as small, sporty offerings. Cadillac has ended production on its Seville. Also, 2005 will be the last year in production for GM's attempt at the Continuously Variable Transmission, as used in some Saturn Vue models. Ford's F150 Heritage Pick Up (the old body style truck) is no longer being produced. The low end of the pick up line will be the new body style available for the first time with a six-cylinder engine and manual transmission.

Ford Five Hundred and Mercury Montego are new sedans with prices starting in the low \$20,000 range. General Motors will bring out completely redesigned mini-vans wearing Chevrolet, Pontiac, and Buick nametags. These vans will replace previous lines with a more pronounced and longer hood. Toyota is increasing production of its Prius Hybrid to accommodate strong US sales.

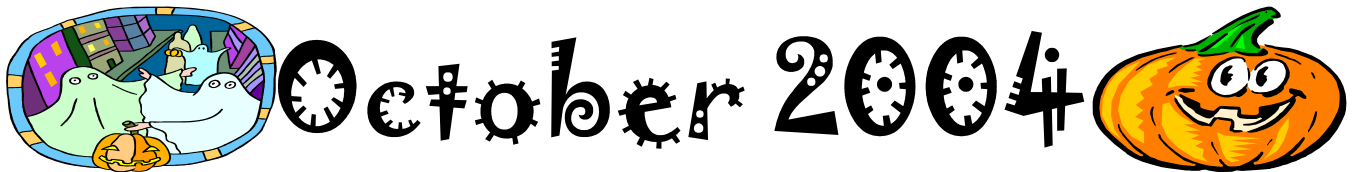
