



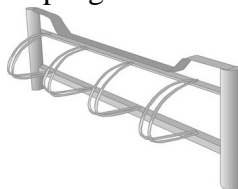

What's happening in our community??

..... Updated information from your Transition Committee Team

Following is a brief listing of some of the actions taken recently ... or ones in progress at this time

- trash cans
 - new & larger trash cans have been purchased for the bathrooms
 - the Board has approved the purchase of concrete trash cans to be located throughout our community
- research is being done regarding the need for additional alley mirrors
- review/evaluation of Knight Janitorial services is in progress
- a bike rack has been ordered
- two windows (rotted) have been replaced in the clubhouse
 - a north office window
 - one of the west windows in the pool room
- Legacy Links is considering modifications to the sprinkler systems adjacent to the Clubhouse beds – to prevent spraying on the windows, which is a major cause for the window rotting issues
- Legacy Links is preparing a proposal to irrigate the common area on History Circle (balance of this area is already irrigated)
- SBB is checking into installation of bollards (metal protective pipes) immediately west of the playground by the Clubhouse (to protect traffic from running into this area as they are heading east on Patriot, turning on to Village Boulevard).
- the bid to power wash and clean the windows in the Clubhouse has been approved ... this work has been done.



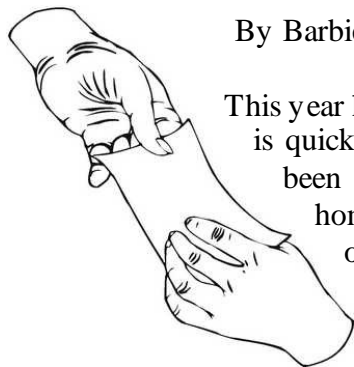

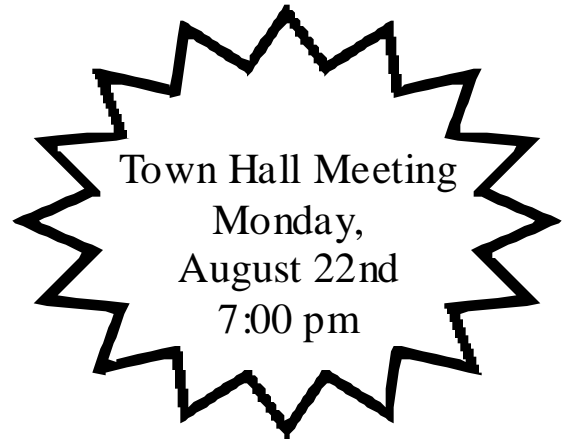

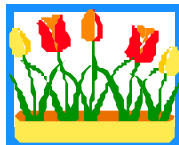

August Recipe: Vegetable Salad

- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp pepper
- 3/4 c red wine vinegar
- 1/2 c salad oil
- 1 c sugar (with Splenda, use less)



Mix together, bring to a boil and set aside to cool.

- 1 can French style green beans
- 1 can small peas
- 1 can white corn
- 1 jar chopped pimiento
- 1 green pepper, chopped
- 2 celery stalks, chopped
- 1 large purple onion chopped

Pour cooled liquid over vegetables. Toss lightly and set in refrigerator over night. Will keep for 2-3 weeks or longer. Serves 10-12.

Note: Don't try other canned vegetables like kidney beans or chickpeas. They don't work. You can use different colored peppers. Don't use frozen veggies.

Members of the Transition Committee have met with a member of the Board at Starwood, who was also a part of their Transition Committee. In doing this, we were able to gather a lot of great ideas that can help us towards our own transition. We learned that we are well on track with the information that we have already gathered. In addition, we also learned that five of us cannot complete all of the tasks and that we will need to establish committees.

The Transition Committee had a meeting on July 18 to go over in detail the items that still need to be addressed for the transition process and to identify several necessary and key committees. 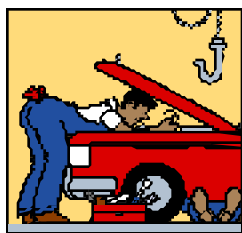
