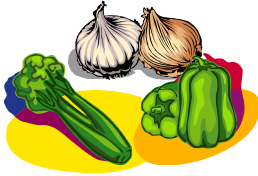

Resident Recipe of the Month

Chicken Almond Casserole

2 lb. pork sausage (1 lb. hot and 1 lb. regular)
2 large onions
2 bell peppers
1 large bunch celery



10 cups water
2 cups raw brown rice
1 cup slivered almonds
3 boxes Lipton's Chicken Noodle Soup with white chicken meat

Brown sausage slightly; add chopped onion, pepper, and celery. Cook until about half done in large pan. Boil water; add rice and soup mix. Cook while meat and vegetables are cooking. Put all together and add almonds.

Bake 1 hour at 350*. This dish is best frozen and reheated before serving. May need to add a cup or so of water when reheating.
